



User already Authenticated?

This step checks if a user is already authenticated based on the provided cookie.

Sessions are handled by the CakePHP's Session Component. Validity of a session is ensured via the component's own logic and includes checks such as comparison against User Agent and Time.

If inconsistencies or tampering is detected. The session is destroyed and a new one is created.

Action is unlocked?

Some endpoints have their security checks disabled. Such actions have to be unlocked in their respective controllers.

Disable CSRF protection

When using the API, form's security tokens are not available. If the CSRF protection was enabled, none of the API calls POSTing data would be allowed.
